Excerpt from The American Journal of Ophthalmology, Vol. 22: January, 1905 Eversion of the upper lid showed a like condition of the upper-cul-de-sac. The lachrymal sac was apparently unaffected, the naso-lachrymal duct was patent; right eye normal. During the two weeks following the patient was treated every second day in the clinic with a weak solution of corrosive sublimate and careful cleansing of the conjunctiva; the eye was washed out several times a day at home. Later, applications, first of powdered boric acid, then of iodoform, were made and all without the slightest effect on the progress. She was then sent to the rhinologist, who found a cystic turbinate with an accompanying rhinitis and probable involvement of the ethmoidal cells. The turbinate was removed and the nose cleansed frequently, which seemed to have a favorable effect on the conjunctivitis. Nevertheless the latter did not entirely disappear, and when the patient was last seen, after two months of treatment, there was still a considerable amount of conjunctival injection and discharge, although she had attended the clinic faithfully and...
