Excerpt from Physical Chemistry of Vital Phenomena: For Students and Investigators in the Biological and Medical Sciences This book comprises a course of lectures and laboratory work given to graduate and advanced medical students in the University of Minnesota. The need for special teaching in the application of the simpler aspects of physical chemistry to biology was first realized by the author while attempting to teach physics and physiology to the same group of college students in 1906. A collection of abstracts of papers on the subject was commenced but interrupted by various affairs, especially the change to medical teaching. It became evident, however, that even medical students with a crowded curriculum would do well to devote any available time to this subject if they expect to do any research or read current medical literature. The purpose of the book is not to go far into physical chemistry but to develop a tool for physiological research. Lengthy discussions of debated questions are avoided by tentatively accepting the hypothesis which fits the most facts, until a better one...
